constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. Minutes of the meeting of March 18, 1952, approved on motion of Commissioner Snell, second by Commissioner Zeagler.

2. An ordinance amending the ordinance which prohibits the obstruction of streets, etc. by trains was passed on motion of Commissioner Stegall, second by Commissioner Zeagler, and passed on second reading on motion of Commissioner Zeagler, second by Commissioner Stegall.

3. The Lufkin Foundry requested permission to install a red and green traffic light on South Raguet at the point to be agreed upon by the City Manager and the Foundry Officials.

4. On motion of Commissioner Snell, seconded by Commissioner Zeagler, a quit claim deed to an alley joining Wilson and Weaver Streets was approved.

5. Authority was granted the City Manager to purchase two new garbage trucks from the Angelina Chevrolet Company, according to their bid, on motion of Commissioner Stegall, seconded by Commissioner Zeagler. Bids submitted were as follows:

Angelina Chevrolet Company, 2 - 1952 - 2 ton Chevrolet trucks less trade in of old trucks-----\$ 4,632.19

Henderson-Medford Motor Company - 2 - 1952 - 2 ton trucks less trade in of old trucks-----\$ 5,200.00

S. C. Mitchell Motor Company - 2 - 1952 - 2 ton Studebaker trucks less trade in of old trucks-----\$ 4,714.80

6. The returns of the election were examined by the Commission and approved. A resolution canvassing the returns and declaring the results thereof was approved on motion of Commissioner Stegall, second Commissioner Treadwell.
