

MINUTES OF Regular MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD April 15th,
1952, at 7:30 P. M.

On this the 15th day of April, 1952, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened in Regular Session in the regular meeting place in said City, with the following members thereof to-wit:

constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. The minutes of the April 1st meeting were read and on motion of Commissioner Zeagler, seconded by Commissioner Stegall, the minutes were approved.

2. Two zone changes, previously applied for and duly advertised, were given final approval on motion of Commissioner Zeagler, seconded by Commissioner Stegall.

3. A zone change application submitted by J. C. Koch, for property located on Frank Avenue, was approved to be advertised on motion of Commissioner Zeagler, seconded by Commissioner Stegall.

4. On motion of Commissioner Nerren, seconded by Commissioner Brittain, the Commission found the existence of a public convenience and necessity in Lufkin for additional taxi cab service. On motion of Commissioner Stegall, seconded by Commissioner Zeagler, the Commission voted to grant an application by Roy Bazzoon for the issuance of three taxi-cab permits.

5. The Commission requested City Attorney Brazil to draw up a proposed franchise agreement for the licensing of a television reception, amplification, and transmitting system, such franchise having been previously applied for by the representative of a private company.

6. The March bills were approved on motion of Commissioner Stegall, seconded by Commissioner Nerren.

7. Authority was granted to adjust delinquent taxes to known subsidiary ledger control figures, on motion of Commissioner Stegall, seconded by Commissioner Nerren.
