
a quorum being present, the following business was trans-
acted:


1. The meeting was called for the purpose of ratify-
ing and accepting easements from the Lufkin Independent
School District to the City of Lufkin, that is the City of
Lufkin had heretofore been given by R. J. Behannon verbal
easements to lay and construct across his land a 12 inch
sewer line and a 6 inch sewer line, and he having sold said
premises to the Lufkin Independent School District, it has
become necessary to define and establish in writing said
easements. Mr. Behannon having sold said tracts of land
upon which said sewer lines are located to the Lufkin In-
dependent School District and the Lufkin Independent School
District is desirous of defining said easements and said
easements being 20 feet in width that is 10 feet on each
side of the present sewer lines under and across said tracts
of land.


2. Motion was made by Commissioner Nerren and second-
ed by Commissioner Stegall that the City of Lufkin accept

the said 20 foot sewer line easement across said tracts of land purchased by the Lufkin Independent School District from the said R. J. Behannon. Such motion was put to a vote and Commissioners Nerren, Stegall and Brittain voted for accepting such sewer easements, no one voted against same.


There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned.
