ing business was transacted:

1. The meeting was opened with prayer by Mayor Pro-Tein,  
W. F. Collins.
2. The minutes of the meeting of October 19 were read  
and approved.
3. Mr. J. L. Braswell, 2007 Paul Avenue appeared before  
commission complaining about not getting services for the amount of  
taxes he pays. He was informed by Mr. Sherrill that Mr. Flournoy  
would make a estimate of cost of materials to run sewer line to his  
property.
4. It was agreed to extend free water priviledges to  
churches within one-half mile of city limits where facalities are  
available.
5. It was agreed to grant Square Deal Taxi on additional  
taxi cab.
6. Mr. S. N. Berry submitted bid for three houses on new  
right-o-way of Lufkin Avenue. His bid was \$200.00 for each house and  
he would move same from right-o-way. It was agreed to look at houses  
and make a decision by next regular meeting.
