MINUTES OF <u>REGULAR</u> MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, <u>HELD</u> DECEMBER 6. 1955, <u>AT</u> 7:30 P. M.

On this the <u>6th</u> day of <u>December</u>, A. D. 1955, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened in <u>regular</u> session, in the regular meeting place in said City, with the following members thereof, to-wit:

being present, and the following absent: <u>Granville Wright</u>, Commissioner, Ward 1 , constituting a quorum when the follow-

ing business was transacted:

1. The meeting was opened with prayer by Mayor Woodrow W. Scott.

2. The minutes of the regular meeting of November 15, 1955, were read and approved.

3. The Commission declined to lease a portion of the Municipal Airport grounds to be used as a "drag-strip" for racing automobiles. Such action was taken after the City Attorney advised the Commission that there could be legal liability against the City under certain conditions relative to such use of a portion of its land.

4. A list of citizens was selected with K. W. Denman as Temporary Chairman to study the City Charter and make a report as to the advisability of writing a new charter or making changes in the present City Charter.

5. Thelma McClain was granted a zone change from "B" to "F" District on Lot No. 1, Block No. 48, of the Original Town of Lufkin, Texas.

6. The City Commission authorized the payment of the usual Christmas bonus to its employees, that is, 25% of one months salary for those who have been employed for one year or longer; 10% of a months salary for those who have been employed not less than six months or longer than one year; and \$10.00 for those who have been employed for less than six months. 6. Mr. Harvey Sprott, Forester, for the Angelina County Lumber Company, gave a report that he marked trees on the Jones Lake and the City Lake property and suggested the sale of different types of trees as outlined in his written report of the timber. He recommended that certain sizes of the trees be advertised for sale.

7. The zone was changed on Lot No. 2B, Block No. 46, of the Denman Addition, owned by W. O. Boatman, wasxchanged from "A" District to "F" District.

8. The ordinance regulating the speed limit on the Old Diboll Highway or Southwood Drive was passed on final reading, as recommended by the State Highway Department.

9. Bills for the month of October were approved and ordered paid.

10. There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned.
