those present, constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. The meeting was opened with prayer by Mayor S. R. Parker, Jr.
  2. The City Commission passed a resolution as prepared by the Texas State Highway Department approving the widening of pavement from Old South city limits to Denman Avenue, a distance of approximately 0.5 miles; and from Fred Street to Hoskins Street, a distance of approximately 0.2 mile (U.S. 59 business route in the City of Lufkin).
  3. Mr. Marion Clay, Ned Shands, Jr. and Dr. L. H. Denman appeared before the City Commission in the interest of increased telephone rates for the Lufkin Telephone Exchange. Rates were discussed generally, as well as the service rendered by the Lufkin Telephone Exchange. The Commission requested additional information and action on application for increased rates was postponed until the next regular meeting.
  4. There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting adjourned.
