City, with the following members thereof, towit:



 the following business was transacted:

1. The meeting was opened with prayer by Commissioner W. F. Collins.
2. The minutes of the regular meeting of November 18, 1958, were read and approved.
3. Mr. Wade Keene appeared before the commission and discussed the trains blocking the Dozier Street and the Ellis Avenue crossings. He suggested that, if possible, the trains be kept in the yards in the north part of the City. The matter of the trains blocking the crossings in the City was discussed and Mr. Keene was advised that the City would do everything within it's power to remedy the blocking of street crossings by the trains.
4. The Tax Collector and Assessor, Mr. Braden, and his assistant, Granville Wright, appeared before the commission and explained the reason for the proposed check-off of taxes due on automobiles. After hearing their explanation for such suggested check-offs, the commission voted to eliminate from the rolls whatever taxes might be due on such personal property, as recommended by the assessor-collector.
5. The ordinance annexing a portion of the Sussex Downs Addition was unanimously passed on second and final reading.
6. The City Attorney was instructed to prepare an ordinance regulating pedestrian traffic at the street intersections where there are traffic signals, and have same ready at the next meeting of the commission.
7. Consideration of the ordinance borrowing \$90,000.00 from the Lufkin National Bank was postponed until the next regular meeting of the City Commission.


8. Consideration of the budget, as submitted by the City Manager, was postponed to a called meeting, Tuesday, December 9th, 1958, 7:30, P.M.
