

Sufkin 2400 Aug-17-1917

The City Council met in adjourned session with the following present and acting R. B. Shenen Mayor; C. B. Sargent and J. B. McCormick aldermen. The Secretary being absent Dr. A. J. O'Brien was appointed to act as Secretary pro tem.

Mrs. W. C. Grant reported that he had talked with manager of the pipe line and that up to the present he been unable to learn anything in regard to the matter of furnishing water on account of not being able to get the General manager over the phone.

E. J. Mautsath made a proposition to furnish water from his lake on a rate of \$300.00 per month payable in advance. Contract to run 60 days. On motion of Burke seconded by Sargent this proposition was accepted for a period of 60 days to begin when pump and all connections are made and everything is ready to pump water. The city to proceed to make all connections as soon as possible. City instructed to issue warrant as soon as city begins to take water.

On motion of Sargent Dec. by Burke E. J. Mautsath was allowed \$250.00 as per due in case of J. H. Sargent vs City of Sufkin.
