ELECTION ORDER.

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Lufkin, Texas, deem it advisable to issue bonds of the said City for the purpose hereinafter mentioned.

Therefore, Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of

Lufkin, that an election be held on the 27th day of August A.D. 1908 at the City Station in the City of Lufkin, Texas, submitting the following proposition to the qualified voters of the City of Lufkin, Texas.

Shall the City Council of the City of Lufkin, Texas, be authorized to issue the bonds of the said City of Lufkin, Texas, in the sum of

Ten Thousand Dollars payable in Twenty years after date, bearing interest at the rate of five per cent per annum annually, and to levy a tax sufficient to redeem them at maturity, to procure funds with which to extend and improve the water work system of Lufkin, J. E. Peary is hereby appointed manager of the said election.

Said election shall be held under the provisions of Chapter No. 149, Acts of the 26th. Legislature Laws 1899, and only qualified voters who are property tax payers of the said City, shall be allowed to vote.

All legal voters desiring to support the proposition to issue the bonds shall have printed upon their ballots the words "Agreement"

& those opposed shall have printed upon their ballots the words "Opposition". The manner of conducting the election shall be governed by the laws of the State.
