

1892 Suffolk Texas May 3rd 1892

Town Council of the town of Suffolk met in regular session Mayor J. C. Mautook in the chair. Alderman Kerr Mautook Thomas Dennon and McPherson present Minutes of last meeting read and adopted. Moved and carried that the aldermans not be allowed any thing for their services.

Moved and carried that W. M. Jones be allowed \$85¹² up to Dec 1st 1891.

Moved and carried that W. M. Jones be allowed \$40⁰⁰ for services in full payment up to the 13th of April 1892. Moved and carried

W. M. Jones be allowed \$40⁰⁰ per month as marshal of town of Suffolk until further ordered. Moved and

carried that J. C. Mautook be allowed \$25⁰⁰ per month as Mayor of the town of Suffolk until further ordered. Moved and

carried that the ad valorem tax law be suspended. Acct of J. C. Mautook for \$40⁰⁰ for stationary be allowed and paid. Acct of J. P. Weeks 2⁰⁰ for house rent from April the 13th 92 until May 13th 92 be allowed and ordered paid.

Lufkin Texas May 3/92.

Art. Betting at Table or Bank or certain Games

Be it ordained by the town Council of town of Lufkin Texas If any person shall bet or wager at any gaming table or bank or pigeon hole or Jenny-Lin table or near or ten pin alley or shall bet or Wager any money or other things of value at any of the games included in the preceding articles or at any of the followingo games Viz: Poker-Dice, Jack-pot, high-dice lowdice Dominoes eucher with Dominoes poke with Dominoes seth with Dominoes, muggins, crack-loo crack or loo or at any game of any character whatever that can be played with Dice or dominoes, or at any table, bank or alley by what soever the name may be known by and without reference as to how the same may be construed or operated, he shall be fine not less than ten nor more than twenty five Dollars, provided that no person shall be indicted under this section for playing any of said games with dice or dominoes at a private residence.

Suffkin Texas May 3rd 1892

Be it ordained by the town Council of the town of Suffkin Texas,

That article 44 of the ordinance of the town of Suffkin Texas be so amended to read as follows:

Art. 44- It shall not be lawful for any male person, who or not an employee of the Rail Road Company or Passenger Carriage in or going out of said Corporate limits to Climb to or get on or off of any Rail Road engine or car while said engine or car is in motion in the corporate limits of the town of Suffkin Texas. Any person violating any of the provisions of this article shall be fine in any sum not to exceed Twenty Five Dollars.
