 The City Council of the City of Lufkin
 met in regular session with the
 following present & acting -

The minutes of Aug 9th and Sept 21st 1904
 were read and approved.

City Attorney Abney was instructed by
 Mayor to proceed at once to have
 the awnings on the old Bonner Store building
 condemned and repaired -

Street-Cover H. Dawson being absent
 from City had no report, and as
 said Street-Cover will be out of
 City for an indefinite length of time,
 the Mayor appointed H. D. Hearn to
 fill the position of Street-Cover said
 appointment was approved by the board
 of Aldermen and Street-Cover to be allowed \$200⁰⁰/₁₀₀
 dollars per day for each day's services
 rendered the City of Lufkin,

The Committee previously appointed
 to secure a suitable location for
 calaboose and recorders Court discharged
 and the following new Committee appointed
 to secure a suitable location and confer

Lupton Tex Oct 17th 1904,
with contractors and builders for the building
of a Calaboose ^{and} recorded Court room.
This Committee instructed to make
report at next regular meeting,
Committee H. D. Weaver, D. Simpson
& D. Campbell

Committee previously appointed to have
1st street extended to City Limits made
their report, assisted by the City Engineer,
Dix F. Abney, ^{City Atty} was then ^{authorized} instructed to
proceed to get deeds to said street and
have same properly recorded etc, on
Motion by Largent ^{and} 2nd by price, unanimously carried,

Report of Com. Glenn City Treasurer was
read and approved on Motion of Largent
seconded by Shuren ^{and} unanimous vote of all present,
Report shows \$1621¹⁴ in General Fund and
\$2471⁷⁴ water works fund -

Body instructed to cancel scrip amounting
to \$1138²⁶ and Coupons amounting to \$280⁰⁰
Treasurer instructed to have above report published
in the Weekly Tribune

Report of D. Campbell Tax Collector was
read & approved showing amounts
collected as follows,
Ad Valorem \$1188, water \$1188, Poll 2⁰⁰, Penalty 2⁵⁰,
Occupation 12⁵⁰,

D. A. Singleton who was appointed as
a committee by the Lupton Council Club to
coact on City Council, explained to
the said City Council the necessity of appointing
a city Marshall for the protection of property
etc,

Oct 4th 1904,

On motion of Alderman Largent & second by Price
 the following ordinance was passed
 by unanimous vote of all present,
 Be it remembered that on this 4th day
 of October 1904 at a regular session
 of the City Council of the City of Lufkin, it
 appearing that the Office of City Marshall
 is vacant, came on to be heard the
 question of the appointment of a City
 Marshall and it appearing that Hon
 Am Deussen Mayor had appointed
 B. F. Nerrow to act as City Marshall
 for the City of Lufkin Texas, therefore, Be
 it ordained by the City Council of
 the City of Lufkin that the appointment
 of B. F. Nerrow as City Marshall be
 and is hereby ratified and said B. F.
 Nerrow is hereby appointed
 City Marshall of said City to enter
 upon his duties as said officer
 when he has qualified as the
 Law directs and executes a good
 and sufficient bond in the sum of
 \$1000⁰⁰ to be approved by the Mayor
 of said City the salary of said
 officer to be \$40⁰⁰ per month
 and perquisites of the office,

On motion of Price second by
 Largent that the salary of City
 Marshal be raised
 from \$45⁰⁰ per mo to \$50⁰⁰ per month -
 unanimously carried
