 Election and to consider whether
 or no the City of Lufkin should
 exercise the right granted under
 Mass Lane Act.

Lufkin Sept 8th 1908

On Motion of W.D. Price & see by
 C.A. Burke that the following order
 be passed - All voted Aye -

At a meeting of the City Council held
 on the 8th day of September A.D. 1908
 came on to be considered the returns
 of an Election held on the 27th day
 of August A.D. 1908, to determine whether
 or not bonds of the said City should
 be issued; to the amount of
 Ten Thousands Dollars bearing interest
 at the rate of 5%, payable in (20) Twenty
 years after date, payable annually
 and to levy a Tax sufficient to pay
 the interest on said Bonds and
 create a sinking fund sufficient to
 redeem them at maturity to procure
 funds with which to pay for the extension
 and improvement of the water works system
 of Lufkin Texas. And it appearing
 that said Election in all respects
 lawfully held and said returns duly &
 legally made and that there were
 cast at said Election 86 Votes
 of which number 61 were cast
 for the issuance of Bonds and 25
 were cast against the issuance of
 Bonds, It is therefore ordered that
 the proposition to issue said bonds
 and levy said tax was sustained by a
 majority of the qualified property tax payers
 voting at said Election and that the City
 Council of the said City is authorized
 to issue said bonds and to levy & have
 assessed & collected said Tax.
