being present, constituting a quorum, when the following business was transacted:

- 1. Meeting opened with prayer by City Manager Reagan Parker.
- 2. Mayor stated special meeting was called for the purpose of deciding on awarding contracts for work in connection with Water Distribution System, bids on which were opened May 17, 1966.

Mr. E. C. Kobs, Jr., Vice-President, along with Mr. Robert K. Burchard, of Bernard Johnson Engineers, Inc., City's Consulting Engineers, were present and Mayor requested Mr. Kobs to give recommendations on awarding of the contracts. Mr. Kobs stated it was his Company's recommendation, after a very comprehensive study of the bids, that City award the contract on Schedule I, in the amount of \$209,227.00, to Gulfline Constructors, Inc., Beaumont, Texas, (Bidder); Schedule II to Gulfline Constructors, Inc., in the amount of \$101,935.00 (Chicago Bridge and Iron Works, Bidder); and Schedule III to Gulfline Constructors, Inc., in the amount of \$55,447.00 (Layne Texas Co,, Inc., Bidder); total being \$366,609.00.

Mr. Kobs recommended the City accept the extension of construction time from 90 to 180 days and alternate paint specifications offered in bid of Chicago Bridge and Iron Works bid for Schedule II. Mr. Kobs also recommended that City retain the option of awarding contract in connection with additive alternates 1 thru 5, Schedule I, if desired. It was also his recommendation that City award one bid to Gulfline Constructors, Inc. on Schedule I, II, and III rather than awarding three separate bids, and that Chicago Bridge and Iron Works and Layne Texas Co., Inc., have agreed to work with Gulfline Constructors, Inc., in performing this work.

Commissioner Earl Nisbet made motion that recommendations of Mr. Kobs, Vice-President of Bernard Johnson Engineers, Inc., be accepted by the City. Motion was seconded by Commissioner William F. Prince and a unanimous affirmative vote was recorded.

3. There being no further business for consideration, meeting was adjourned at 10:00 A.M.
