The purpose of this meeting was  
 for purpose of entering into  
 contract with Messrs Layton & Bowler  
 for prospecting for oil on the  
 property owned by the City of Lufkin  
 Texas, known as the City Reservoir,  
 and to dispose of claim of C. S. Eastham  
 for laying sewer and water mains.

On Motion of C. A. Bunske & Sec by  
 Price, that the claim of C. S. Eastham  
 for \$594<sup>90</sup> for laying 1328 ft 12" sewer  
 pipe @ 25¢ and 1897 feet 8" sewer pipe @ 20¢
