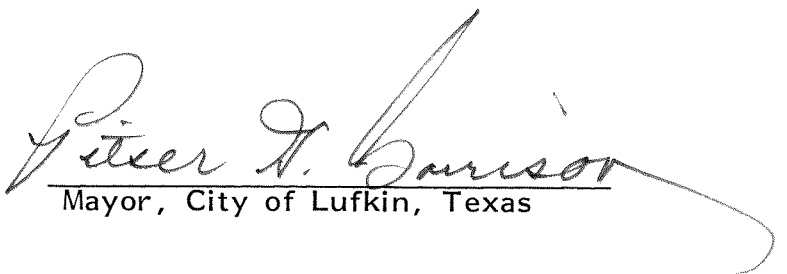

1. Meeting opened with prayer by City Manager Westerholm.
2. Mayor Garrison stated that the Special Meeting had been called to consider two (2) real estate transactions. Mayor Garrison adjourned special open meeting of City Commission at 12:05 p.m. to Executive Session for consideration of same.
3. The City Commission reconvened at 1:35 p.m. and Mayor Garrison stated that the following matters were discussed in Executive Session:
 - a. A street right-of-way which needed to be studied in further detail before making announcement.
 - b. Chambers Park - City Commission felt the City of Lufkin could not proceed with relocation under the decision made by the Lufkin School Board. The City Commission decided to invite the School Board to meet with them in Executive Session to ascertain if there was any possibility of reaching a solution.
