When the following proceedings, among others, were had, to-wit:

The purpose of the meeting as then explained by the Mayor being to dispose of such business as may properly come before the council.

Moved and seconded that the Lufkin Light and Power Co be granted an extension of twenty five years of their franchise, ^{as read} beginning January 1st 1925 when the present franchise now in force will expire, with the exception that that clause be struck out and canceled which reads as follows: "It is agreed that in event any damages shall accrue to the Lufkin Electric Light & Power Co by reason of the wires of the City being strung on the poles of the Company, such damages shall be borne and paid by the City of Lufkin and not by the Lufkin Light and Power Company" - And that the following clause be inserted: "The Company also agrees to not man or injure shade or

ornamental trees that are in line of
or in the way of its wires, except by
permission of the owners of the trees
or if unable to procure such permission
then by the ~~case~~ Mayor of the City —
Motion prevailed, Callemorgen & Singleton
voting aye and Blosser voting no.

Motion carried that Alderman Callemorgen
be retained as a committee of one to
effect an amicable settlement with Surcan
and Hambrick for damaged cotton.

Motion carried that the City offer
the Board of Trustees of the Lufkin High
school the sum of \$100- in a Town Warrant
for the purpose of building an extension
of the 8" sewer line from the point
where it now stops in front of Callemorgen's
store to ~~the~~ a point on north 1st street
where the school could make closer
connections with same.

Motion carried to adjourn and celebrate Alderman Callmorgen's 39th birthday.

Motion by Singator seconded by Callmorgen and all voting aye that the ~~City install~~ ~~the~~ lighting committee be granted further time in which to confer with the officials of the Light Plant with reference to lighting the town.
