Report of Loop Turn read and approved showing the following: Cases over 8 - Direct to City 8⁰⁰ Reorder over 8⁰⁰ Clerk fees 13⁶⁰ Marshal fees 12⁰⁰ Deputy Marshal fees 4⁰⁰ Attorneys fees 21⁰⁰

Report of B. S. Neven read and approved showing 8 dogs disposed of, and warrant ordered issued to cover. Report of Street Comm read but Council would not approve same and City ordered to return same to Street Comm of Walker for his certification.

Report of Tax Assessor read but on account of its not being certified to before a competent officer in way ordered returned to Mr. Bedford for his certification.

Motion by Coemorgen and seconded by Singleton and motion carried that Mayor Amason and Alderman McMillen be empowered with authority to buy two more horses for use by the City in its Street Fire and water departments, and warrant to pay for same be drawn on the Street and Alley Fund but it is specifically understood that the amount used for this purpose be returned

to this fund as soon as practicable out of the water works operating department motion by Singleton seconded by Burke all aldermen voting aye, that in consideration of his services rendered this city in the past, and for that he will render in the years to come, as chief of the Fire Department, this council grant unto C. N. Amason, and the City of Lufkin by these presents, does grant unto said C. N. Amason the privilege to hunt and fish on all the city's waters, composed of the old city pond or pond #1, and the New City pond or pond #2 for the next ten years.

The City Clerk instructed to notify the city attorney to bring suit against the owners of buildings whose awnings are in a dilapidated and dangerous condition and compel them to tear down said awnings or repair same.

Bills and accounts allowed as read after there being no further business, meeting adjourned
