The object of the meeting being to devise ways and means of providing funds wherewith to operate the Fire Dept of the City of Lufkin, in appearing there on account of the low cash value of City Town Harrets. The firmen could longer serve, neither would feed for horses be supplied at cash prices. Fire Chief C. N. Thurason appeared before Council and offered a proposition whereby the department could be operated almost independent of the City's finances. Mayor appointed Alderman
