The purpose of the meeting as explained by the Mayor was to accord a hearing to Mr. M. C. Erwin of the Onie Engineering Co. of Dallas as to the merits of their company in superintending construction work here in the City of Lufkin contemplating installing soon

After thoroughly looking into the proposition as outlined by Mr. Erwin it was moved by Alderman Ceeuwagen seconded by Singleton and approved by the Mayor and Secretary <sup>in their official capacity</sup> be empowered with authority to execute contract (said contract being read in open Council and approved by same) with the Onie Engineering Co. of Dallas to cover the construction of improvements and the purchase of material used with the exception of such material already purchased by the City.
