McCarthy et al. anent the reestablishing of a sewer system in the Town of Lufkin, and to ascertain the disposition of this City Council as to the granting a franchise to some one who would finance the proposition.

After reading a franchise covering same submitted by said McCarthy et al. a motion was carried that the Council each col- <sup>tively</sup> and individually, look carefully into the matter and report at the next regular meeting of the Council.
