## 2. <u>RESOLUTION - APPROVED - ISSUANCE OF BONDS - LUFKIN HEALTH FACILITIES DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION - MEMORIAL HEALTH SYSTEM OF EAST TEXAS</u>
