

Lufkin, Texas, Oct. 9th., 1914.

Be it remembered that on this the 9th. day of October, A. D. 1914, there came on and was held a ~~xxxx~~ SPECIAL CALL meeting of the City Council of the City of Lufkin, Texas, in the council chambers of said City, there being present and presiding the following officers:

When the following proceedings, among others, were had to-wit:

The object of the meeting being an adjourned meeting of Oct. 6th., the Mayor announced the Council was ready to continue its labors, and act upon such matters as may properly come before them.

Mr. Grant Hornaday, representing the National Water Purifying Company, appeared before the Council setting forth the merits of his method of Clarifying and purifying water. The members of the Council again went into the details of the construction as well as the method employed in the operation of his plants.

Alderman Glenn offered a motion, seconded by alderman Kerr, all aldermen voting aye, that Aldermen Gibson and Taylor visit the towns of Brownwood and Kaufman, as well as any other place they see fit, to investigate this system of filtration and any other methods employed.

Mr. G. T. Cross as chairman of a committee appointed to recheck the City tax rolls, for possible errors and unrendered property made a verbal report to the Council, naming some things accomplished by this committee, and offered many suggestions for the benefit of the City.

The City Engineer submitted some plans and profiles showing a proposed spillway for the new City reservoir.

A motion prevailed that the City Engineer be instructed to prepare plans and specifications for a spillway and submit them to the next meeting of the Council for approval at its next meeting.

Minutes of the City Council, October 9th., 1914, continued.

Motion by alderman Gibson, seconded by alderman Taylor, all aldermen voting aye, that the following ordinance be passed, styled,
"AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE DISTRIBUTION OF REVENUES DERIVED FROM TAXES LEVIED WITHIN THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, UNDER AN ORDINANCE PASSED, ADOPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, APPROVED ON THE 20th. DAY OF JUNE, A. D. 1914" and the same is hereby passed and approved.

There being no further business a motion was carried to adjourn.
