B. Fowler be allowed \$25.00 as compensation for getting up a new code of laws and submit them ~~to~~ the Council.

Dinson and request him to give the new Council a statement of the business transacted by him during his official term as City Marshall of the town of Luffkin. Also to get a statement from W. P. N. Duvor ^{former} Treasurer. The salary of the City Marshall was fixed at \$30.00 per month for the ensuing year. There being no further business the Council adjourned sine die.
