7. PURCHASE OF FOURTEEN (14) BUS STOP SHELTERS **FROM BRASCO** INTERNATIONAL, INC. - APPROVED.

Interim City Manager Kevin Gee stated part of the Capital Improvement plan included the installation of fourteen (14) bus stop shelters. Interim City Manager Gee furthered Staff had coordinated with Brazos Transit for the locations of the shelters along the routes and the exact locations would be coordinated with Council. Interim City Manager Gee explained the item being voted on was for the acquisition of the shelters. Interim City Manager Gee stated Brasco International was the low bidder in the amount of \$87,500 which did not include installation of the shelters; Street Department Staff would be responsible for the installation. Interim City Manager Gee concluded Staff recommended City Council approve the purchase of fourteen (14) bus stop shelters from Brasco International, Inc. in the amount of \$87,500.00.
