

SUBJECT: Minutes of the City Council Oct. 6th. 1915.

Be it known that pursuant to the adjournment of the regular meeting of the City Council on Oct. 5th. 1915 there came on and was held an adjourned meeting of the City Council of the City of Lufkin, Texas. Those present were as follows:-

It was moved by Alderman Price that the account of Mayor Mantooth amounting to \$66.00 covering freight paid on the three cars of gravel donated by the Urbana Gravel Company be allowed. Motion was seconded by Alderman Behanon and all Aldermen voted "AYE".

Alderman Price moved and Alderman Davis seconded that Ordinance # 95 entitled "AN ORDINANCE ORDERING THE WIDENING OF CONCRETE SIDEWALKS AND CONSTRUCTING THE SAME WITH CONCRETE MATERIAL ALONG THE NORTHERLY FRONT OF LOT ONE IN BLOCK FOUR AND FOR WIDENING AND CONSTRUCTING CONCRETE SIDEWALKS ALONG CERTAIN STREETS IN THE CITY OF LUFKIN; DIRECTING THE CITY ENGINEER TO ESTABLISH AND RE-ESTABLISH WHERE NECESSARY THE GRADES THEREOF, PREPARING THE PROFILES AND SPECIFICATIONS THERE FOR, AND TO RECEIVE BIDS, AND MAKING CERTAIN REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO THE PROPER ENFORCEMENT AND CONDUCT OF SAID IMPROVEMENTS", be adopted as read. All Aldermen voting "AYE"

Moved by Alderman Price seconded by Alderman Behanon that ordinance No. 96 entitled "AN ORDINANCE REPEALING NO. 88 and cancelling certain warrants drawn on the general fund of the City of Lufkin, Texas", be adopted. All Aldermen voting "AYE"



Moved by Alderman Behanon, seconded by Alderman Davis that ~~ordinance~~ resolution No. 97 accepting the proposal of J. L. Arlitt dated October 6th. A. D. 1915 for the purchase of \$25,000 of six per cent interest bearing warrants that may be issued by the City of Lufkin, Texas for permanent improvements at ninety cents on the dollar be adopted. All Aldermen voting "AYE".

There being no further business the Council adjourned to meet again at 8 O'clock P.M. on October 25th. 1915.
