"AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING CERTAIN FUNDS FROM THE SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT FUND TO THE STREAT AN ALLEY OPERATING FUND AND TO THE STRUET AND ALLEY FUND.", same being ordi ance No. 129 of the City of Lufkin.
