

Lufkin Texas Aug. 7th 1918

The City Council of the City of Lufkin Texas met on this the 7th day of August 1918 with the following named officers present; K. Morgan mayor presiding W. D. Price, S. W. Hawthorne W. D. Newsom and Chas L. Bonner aldermen and R. P. Walker secretary when the following orders were passed and made of record by the Council;

It is ordered by the Council that all minutes of the Council meeting held during the month of July 1918 be and the same are hereby approved

It is ordered by the Council that the monthly reports of K. Morgan mayor; R. P. Walker secretary J. S. Cochran marshal; J. I. Driver pound master E. A. Perkins, water Commissioner and W. L. Sullivan Sanitary Inspector for the month of July 1918 be and the same are hereby approved

It is ordered by the Council that the water Commissioner place a meter on the water pipe at the Court house and gauge the water used there for one month and charge Angelina with water for a period of two years dating back two years from the time that said meter is placed the charge to be made in proportion to one months gauge by said meter and then the water Commissioner is hereby instructed to keep a regular water account with the County of Angelina and charge the County the same for water that is charged other water patrons of the City of Lufkin Texas

And in case the county fails to pay its
water service through its legally authorized
agents the water commission is hereby instructed
and required to cut out the water service at
said Angelina County Court House
