

Lufkin Texas Sept. 3<sup>rd</sup> 1918

The City Council of the City of Lufkin Texas met on this the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of Sept. 1918 with the following named officers present, viz;

S. W. Hawthorne, W. D. Price, J. A. Behannon, W. D. Newsom and Chas. L. Bommer Aldermen and R. P. Walker Secretary.

The reports of K. Morgan, Mayor R. P. Walker, Secretary; J. S. Cochran City Marshal Dr. W. W. Dunn City Health officer; P. A. McCarthy City Engineer and W. L. Sullivan Sanitary Inspector were read and approved. The report of E. A. Perkins, Water Commissioner was referred to the Water Committee for investigation.

Ordered by the Council that the Mayor and City Secretary audit all accounts now on file against the City of Lufkin and issue warrants against the proper funds of the City in settlement of such accounts as they may audit and approve there being no further business before the Council and as it is necessary for this Council to meet again soon it is ordered that the Council adjourn subject to the call of the Mayor
