

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE  
CITY COMMISSION HELD AT THE CITY  
HALL AUGUST 5th, 1919.

---

Be it remembered that on this the 5th day of August, A. D. 1919, there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the City Hall thereof in the City of Lufkin, Texas: Presiding the Hon. E. E. Woods, Mayor Protem, Mayor G. A. Kelley, being absent, S. R. Parker, Commission Ward No. 1, C. B. Edwards, Commissioner Ward No. 3 and W. B. Treadwell, Commissioner Ward No. 4 and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

All minutes of former meetings of this Commission which had not been read and approved were read, and by move and second were ordered approved.

---

The resignation of Non Binion, City Marshall, having been accepted the City Manager reports the appointment of R. O. Lout, as City Marshall, at a salary of \$125.00 per month. The said City Manager also reports the appointment of D. F. Costar as Night Marshall at a salary of \$75.00 per month. By move and second duly made and vote of the Commission, said appointments are hereby confirmed.

Accounts against the City for Salaries and Material and Supplies, due up to the First of August, 1919, were presented for payment, and it appearing that all of said accounts had been properly proven and audited by the City Manager, by move and second and vote of the Commission, same were allowed and City Secretary ordered to issue warrants in payment of same.

It appearing to the City Commission that the City had heretofore executed a deed of conveyance to 10 acres of land in favor of T. B. Bledsoe and had never received any consideration of said land, and it now appearing to the said Commission that the said Bledsoe is ready and willing to make payment of the sum of \$200.00 for the said land, it was moved by Commissioner Edwards and Seconded by Commissioner Parker that the said \$200.00 be accepted in payment of said land, which question having been voted upon by the Commission, said motion unanimously carried

Other matters concerning the welfare of the City were discussed, but no action taken, and adjournment was taken.
