

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE
CITY COMMISSION OF LUFKIN, TEXAS,
Held October 7th, 1919.

Be it remembered that on this the 7th day of October, 1919, there was begun and holden a regular session of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal office thereof, Members present S. R. Parker, Commissioner Ward No. 1, E. E. Woods, Commissioner Ward No. 2, C. B. Edwards, Commissioner Ward No. 3 and W. B. Treadwell, Commissioner Ward No. 4. City Manager L. Mitchell and City Secretary T. L. Dunn, also being present, when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

It appearing that Mayor G. A. Kelley was absent on account of sickness and was not able to attend this meeting of the Commission, ~~xxxx~~ on motion duly made and carried E. E. Woods was elected Mayor Pro-Tem, and he at one called the meeting to order

Minutes of previous meetings were read and adopted.

The following officers filed reports for the month ending September 30th. J. T. Maroney, Corporation Judge, T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, Fred R. Davis, Meter man and L. Mitchell, City Manager. Same were examined by the Commission, and on motion duly made and carried were accepted and approved.

"AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE MANNER OF EXECUTION AND INSTALLING PLUMBING WORK AND DRAIN LAYING; FOR THE LICENSE OF PLUMBERS AND DRAIN LAYERS BY THE CITY OF LUFKIN; PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION OF BONDS BY PLUMBERS AND DRAIN LAYERS; FOR THE FILING OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR PLUMBING AND DRAIN LAYING; FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS THEREFOR AND FOR THE SUPERVISING AND EXAMINING OF PLUMBING AND DRAIN LAYING WORK AND OTHER PURPOSES!"

The above ordinance was read and discussed and it appearing that same is an emergency measure was placed upon its second reading, the rules requiring ordinances to be read at two stated meetings and not to become effective until ten (10) days after passage and publication having been suspended, after which motion was made by C. B. Edwards and seconded by W. B. Treadwell to adopt and pass said ordinance as aforesaid, same carried by vote of the Commission and said ordinance declared to be enacted.

Accounts due by the city were presented for allowance and it appearing that same had been duly audited by the City Manager, on motion duly made and carried were allowed, and warrants ordered issued in payment thereof.

Dr. VonHovenberg, representing the St. Louis Southwester Railway Co of Texas in the capacity of eradicating mosquitoes from the City of Lufkin, Texas, presented a proposition, asking for the additional appropriation of \$250.00, to help defray the expenses of such work for the year 1919. On motion duly made and carried it was ordered that such appropriation be made, and payment of same to be made and taken care of in the City Budget for the year 1920.

On motion duly made and carried the meeting adjourned.

Read and approved on this the 4 day of Nov, 1919.
