It was moved and seconded that the report and expense of W.L.Jones,as Water Commissioner for the month of March 1919 be and they are hereby allowed and approved ,except an item of \$15.99 for A.C.Jones which was rejected and the account was allowed for \$206.54 and a warrant for same was ordered to be issued payable out of the Water Works Incidental fund in favor of the Water Commissioner.

Ordered by the Council that J.E.Wilson be permitted to pa the taxes on Lot No.9 in the Milam addition ,said taxes having been assessed against T.E.Battles for the year 1918 together with some personal property Said taxes against said lot #o amounting to \$5.20

Moved and seconded that S.W.Hawthorne ,W.D.Newsom and Chas .L.Bonner meet at the City Hall tomorrow,@pril the 5th and audit the claims outstanding against the city.
