

CALL MEETING.
June 17th, 1920.

On this the 17th day of June, A.D.1920, a call meeting of the City Commission was held at the Municipal office of the City of Lufkin, Texas, with the following members present:- G. A. Kelley, Mayor, S. R. Parker, E. E. Woods, B. L. Zeagler and W. B. Treadwell, Commissioners, L. Mitchell, City Manager and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The question of whether to use shell or rock screenings as a binder for the pavement now being put down for the City of Lufkin, Texas, was thoroughly discussed, after which Commissioner S. R. Parker made a motion that the City use shell as a binder as aforesaid, which said motion was seconded by Commissioner W. B. Treadwell. The question having been put by the Mayor, same carried unanimously, and the Mayor declared said motion carried, and that shell would be used as a screening as aforesaid.

D. Mitchell, whose resignation as City Manager has heretofore been accepted by the City Commission, asked that he be relieved from any further duties by virtue of his said office, and after due consideration of said petition, by move and second duly made and carried, the said L. Mitchell was releaved as per his requisition.

It appearing that the ~~City~~ Office of City Manager is vacant by reason of resignation of L. Mitchell, former City Manager, by move and second duly made and carried T. L. Dunn, was appointed Temporary City Manager, pending the appointment of a Permanent City Manager.
