

MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN,
TEXAS, HELD JULY 26th, 1921.

On this the 26th day of July, A. D. 1921, there was held a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof, with the following members present to-wit:- E. E. Woods, Mayor Protem, presiding, S. R. Parker, Commission of Ward No. 1, B. L. Zeagler, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, W. B. Treadwell, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, J. O. Booker, City Manager, T. L. Dunn, City Secretary and W. O. Seale, City Attorney, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

It appearing to the City Commission that it is necessary that proper Street Signs be erected in the City to secure free mail delivery, it was moved by S. R. Parker and seconded by B. L. Zeagler that the City pay for such signs as are necessary which it is understood will be ordered by the Chamber of Commerce of the City. All members voted aye and the Mayor protem declared the motion carried.

The question of erecting "City Limit" signs on the public highways at their crossing on the city limit line was discussed, after which by move and second duly made and carried, such signs were ordered made and erected as aforesaid.

An ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Providing that all persons failing or refusing to pay the amount of fine and costs adjudged against them in the Corporation Court, may be put to work on the Streets" was presented by the City Attorney, and after reading same and duly considering the passage of such an ordinance, by move and second duly made and carried, such ordinance was passed and approved, such ordinance declaring an emergency.

An ordinance entitled "An Ordinance providing for the preservation of property, health and safety, and amending "An Ordinance regulating motor Vehicles in the City of Lufkin, Texas, of date May 9th, 1914", was presented for passage and approval, and after due consideration of same by move and second duly made and carried such ordinance was passed and approved, delaring an emergency.

There being no furhter business to come before the meeting, by move and second duly made and carried, adjournment was taken.
