

MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY OF
LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD SEPT. 19, 1921.

BE it remembered that on this the 19th day of September, A.D. 1921, there was begun and holden a Special meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the municipal office of the said city of Lufkin, Texas; sitting and presiding the Hon. E.E. Woods, Mayor Pro-Tem., S.R. Parker, Commissioner Ward No. 1; W.B. Treadwell, Commissioner Ward No. 4; and B.L. Zeagler, Commissioner of Ward No. 3 was absent; and T.L. Dunn City Secretary being present the following proceedings we had, to-wit:

Whereas, on the 16th day of August, A.D. 1921, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin served written notice on Mr. J.O. Booker, City Manager, notifying him that on September 17th A.D. 1921, he would be discharged as City Manager of the City of Lufkin, Texas, and

Whereas on the 8th day of September, A.D. 1921, the said J.O. Booker without any notice whatever to any of the city officials of the city of Lufkin, voluntarily absented himself from the city of Lufkin and left the affairs of the City Manager unattended to, and his whereabouts are yet unknown; and

Whereas the said J.O. Booker did not demand a hearing in the matter of his discharge.

On Motion by Commissioner S.R. Parker and seconded by Commissioner B.L. Zeagler all Commissioners present viz: E.E. Woods, S.R. Parker, B.L. Zeagler and W.B. Treadwell voting yea, the said J.O. Booker was declared discharged and the office of City Manager declared vacant.

On Motion of Commissioner Parker and seconded by W. B. Treadwell, all members present to-wit: E. E. Woods, S. R. Parker, B. L. Zeagler and W. B. Treadwell all voting Aye, that T. L. Dunn, be and is hereby appointed Temporary City Manager of the City of Lufkin, Texas.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, by move and second duly made and carried, adjournment was taken.
