## MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD NOVEMBER 1st, 1921.

Be it remembered that on this the 1st day of November, A. D. 1921, there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said City; Present and presiding the Honorable G. A. Kelley, Mayor, S. R. Parker, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, E. E. Woods, Commission of Ward No. 2, W. B. Treadwell, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, (B.L. Zeagler of Ward No. 3 being absent), T. L. Dunn, City Secretary and acting City Manager, and W. O. Seale, City Attorney also being present, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

Accounts due by the City to various parties, firms and corporations were presented for payment, and it appearing that such accounts as have been properly audited and approved by the City Manager should be paid, by move and second duly made and carried, same were allowed and the City Secretary instructed to issue City Warrants in payment of same.

An account of J. O. Booker, former City Manager, and also an account of C. C. Mathews, former City Marshall, in the sums of \$62.50 and \$37.50, respectively, were presented for payment, each of said amounts claimed by the parties to be an amount due them for part of salary for the monts of April and May, 1921. After due consideration of said accounts, it was moved by S. R. Parker, and seconded by B. E. Noods, that said accounts be not paid. The mayor put the question, and requested all memebrs of the City Commission who favord said mothion to vote "Aye" and those who opposed to Vote "No". The following members voted "Aye"- G. A. Kelley, S. R. Parker, E. E. Woods, and W. B. Treadwell. The following members voted "No"- None. B. L. Zeagler, absent and not voting. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried, and payment of said accounts rejected.
