

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS,
HELD MAY THE 2nd. 1922.

Be it remembered on this the 2nd day of May A. D. 1922 there was begun and holden A regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof; present and presiding the Hon. G. A. Kelley Mayor, S. R. Parker Commissioner Ward #1, E. E. Woods Commissioner Ward #2, B. L. Zeagler Commissioner Ward #3 and W. B. Treadwell Commissioner Ward #4, C. N. Humason City Manager, W. O. Seale City Attorney, C. H. Rice City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had to wit:

Minutes of former meetings of the City Commission, read, and by move and second duly made and carried, were adopted.

-----oOo-----

R. W. Kurth Cashier of the Lufkin National Bank met with City Commission with reference to occupying temporary quarters in the City Municipal office while they was building A new building which he stated would require approximatly three months, after discussing the proposition he was instructed by the City Commission to take the matter up with the City Manager and what ever arrangements they could make would be satisfactory.

E. E. Woods and B. L. Zeagler was appointed to assist the City Manager in the adjustment towards the opening up of North first Street.

S. R. Parker and W. B. Treadwell was Appointed to assist the City Manager in the adjustment towards the opening up of the extension of South First Street to make the nessary connections with the main Highway leading toward Homer.

Moved by Zeagler, Seconded by Parker to have the City Engineer look over the proposition of A survey by which the city would be able to move Septic tanks also for the purchaseing of approximatly ten acres of land for same. same having been submitted by vote to the City Commission, same carried unanimously.

Moved by Parker seconded by Zeagler that the anuel permits for the privelege of fishing in the City Lake be placed at \$12.50 per year, same having been submitted by vote to the City Commission, same carried unanimously.

After reading the report of City Engineer P. A. McCarthy on the condition of the Pate building fronting on Dozier Avenue, Moved by Parker Seconded by Zeagler to condemn same and the City Attorney was instructed to take what steps that was nessary in carrying out the above order. same having been submitted by vote to the City Commission same carried unanimously.

Franchise of W. E. Lanter for the purpose of laying gas lines in the city was read befor the City Commission, after reading same, it was moved by Parker Seconded by Woods to table said franchise, same having been submitted by vote to the City Commission, same carried unanimously.

Reading of the Ordinance defining the extension of new fire limits was read and by moved and second duly made same was approved.

Moved by Zeagler Seconded by Parker that the City pay to the H. E. & W. T. Ry. Company the sum of \$500.00 same being the amount agreed by the city towards the laying of A storm sewer and refilling of the unsightly ditch between Angelina Avenue and the tracks of the said Railroad company just south of their Passenger Dapot.

Moved by Parker seconded by Zeagler to have City Manager confer with the property owners adjacent to ditch between Raguet Street and Moore Avenue with reference to opening up said ditch sufficient to allow free passage of water.

W. B. Treaweell, E. E. Woods together with the City Manager was appointed as A committee to investigate the value, condition etc. of The warehouse of Mrs. W. J. Townsend on Lufkin Avenue for the purpose of ~~the~~ purchasing same for the city and report back at our next meeting.

There being no futher business to come before the meeting, by move and second duly made and carried, adjournment was taken.
