Moved by Zeagler Seconded by Woods to reject all bids for the paving of Bremond street, Culverhouse Street and Frank Avenue. same having been submitted by vote to the City commission same carried unanimously.

Moved by Zeagler Seconded by Woods that the City Commission adopt as A standard of pavement 5 or 6 inch reinforced concrete, same having been submitted by vote to the city commission, same carried unanimously.

Moved by Zeagler Seconded by Woods to instruct City Attorney W. O. Seale to take all steps nessary towards the condemnation of that portion of Dozier Avenue from The H. E. & W. T. Ry. Co. track on said street to its intersection of Frank Avenue near the old Eastern Texas Depot. All members present voting aye.
