

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF
THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD FEBRUARY
7th, 1922.

Be it remembered that on this the 7th day of February, A.D. 1922, there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said City: Present and presiding the Hon. G. A. Kelley, Mayor, S. R. Parker, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, B. L. Zeagler, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, W. B. Treadwell, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, (E. E. Woods, Commissioner of Ward No. 2 being absent). City Manager, C. N. Humason and City Secretary, T. L. Dunn and City Attorney, W. O. Seale were also present, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

Minutes of Regular meeting of this Commission held January 3rd, 1922 were read, and on motion of B. L. Zeagler and second by S. R. Parker, same were amended as follows:- The original minutes designated the paving of Dozier Avenue from Angelina Avenue and across the H. E. & W. T. Railroad reservation to its intersection with Herndon Street. Said minutes are hereby amended to read that said portion of Dozier Avenue across said Railroad reservation is not to be paved. With this amendment, the minutes were approved as read.

Minutes of call meeting of the City Commission held January 17th, 1922, were read, and by move and second duly made and carried were approved.

The question of collecting water and sewer rents from the public schools of the city was discussed by the City Commission, after which it was moved by Commissioner S. R. Parker and seconded by Commissioner W. B. Treadwell, that said public schools be forced to pay sewer and water rents. Said motion carried unanimously.

A proposed ordinance regulating Electric wiring for the City of Lufkin, Texas, was submitted and after due consideration and discussion of same it was moved by Commissioner B. L. Zeagler and seconded by Commissioner W. B. Treadwell that the City Attorney be instructed to re-write same making corrections and to prepare copies of same and to mail one copy each to the members of the City Commission and one copy to the State Fire Insurance Commission for their approval before same shall be passed and adopted by this Commission. Said motion unanimously carried.

The question of constructing a sewer line on Mantooth Avenue was discussed by the City Commission after which it was moved by Commissioner B. L. Zeagler and seconded by Commissioner S. R. Parker that said sewer line be constructed from Raguet Street in a westerly direction through Mantooth Avenue as far as in the judgment of the City Manager may seem good.

A petition was presented to the City Commission praying that Mantooth Avenue be paved. After due consideration and discussion of the matter it was moved by Commissioner S. R. Parker and seconded by Commissioner B. L. Zeagler that a survey of said Mantooth Avenue be made from its intersection with Bonner Street in a westerly direction to its intersection with Bynum Street with a view of paving same but it being understood

that same is not designated for pavement at this time.


