

MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF  
THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN,  
TEXAS. HELD JUNE 6th, 1923.

Be it remembered that on this the 6th day of June, there was begun and holden a call meeting of the Hon. City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal office thereof in said City, present and presiding the Hon. Sam H. Kerr, Mayor, ~~xxxxxx~~, J.W. Lewis, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, W. A. Behannon, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, W. B. Treadwell, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, C. N. Humason, City Manager, T. L. Dunn, City Secretary and W. O. Seale, City Attorney, when the following proceedings were had to wit:-

The Mayor announced that the purpose of the meeting was to receive bids for City Depository for the ensuing two years, and called for such bids as were received to be opened and read.

The City Manager stated that only two bids were received and presented same to the City Commission. Upon opening same it was disclosed that they were as follows:-

Guaranty State Bank & Trust Co.---	3-3/4 cents-
Citizens Guaranty State Bank-----	2-3/4 cents.

Said bids were made on daily balances of the City funds. After due consideration of same it was moved by Commissioner J. W. Lewis and seconded by Commissioner W. B. Treadwell, that the bid of the Guaranty State Bank & Trust Company at 3 per cent on Daily Balances be accepted and that said bank be selected as the Depository of the City of Lufkin, Texas, for the ensuing two years. Said motion carried unanimously and the may declared the Guaranty State Bank & Trust Company duly chosen as such depository as aforesaid.
