

MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE  
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS.  
June 20th, 1924.

Be it remembered that on this the 20th day of June, A. D. 1924, a special call meeting of the City of Lufkin Texas, was held at the City Hall in said City, pursuant to published notice and in compliance with Section 29 of the Special Charter of said City, for the purpose of adopting the Budget for the period beginning April 1st, 1924 and ending March 31st, 1925.

After due consideration and deliberation of the question, by move and second duly made and carried the following Budget was unanimously adopted, viz:-
