An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Lufkin, Texas,  
to execute two (2) notes in the name of the City, and payable to the  
order of The Obenchain-Boyer Company, <sup>of Logansport, Ind.,</sup> and in the amount of \$750.00 each,  
to draw interest at the rate of 6% per annum from date until paid, paya-  
ble in one and two years from their date; said notes being the deferred  
payments on <sup>a two-tank chemical engine</sup> Fire Apparatus bought from the said The Obenchain-Boyer Co,  
was presented for passage and approval. Commissioner A. M. Walker made  
a motion that said ordinance be passed, which was seconded by Commis-  
sioner W. A. Behannon. Said Motion carried by the following vote: "AYES"-
