

MINUTES OF CALL MEETING OF
THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD Dec.
16th, 1924.

Be it remembered that on this the 16th day of December, A. D. 1924, there came on and was held a call meeting of the Honorable City Commission of the City of Lufkin, in the City hall of said City, there being present and presiding the following officers: Sam H. Kerr, Mayor, C. F. Becker, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, A. M. Walker, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, W. A. Behannon, Commissioner of Ward No. 3 and Kenneth Hoskins, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, C. N. Humason, City Manager, W. O. Seale, City Attorney, and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

The Mayor stated that among other things, the purpose of the meeting was to decide upon the location of a sewer disposal plant. This question was thoroughly discussed, after which the resolution or ordinance hereinafter recorded was passed.

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT IN THE NAME OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN WITH THE ANGLINA & NECHES RIVER RAILROAD COMPANY FOR RAISING THEIR RAILROAD TRACK A DISTANCE OF ABOUT 1975 FEET AND ALSO RAISING TWO TRETTLES FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE CITY'S WATER RESERVOIR, AND SETTING ASIDE \$2,786.00 OR SO MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE REQUIRED TO PAY FOR MAKING SUCH IMPROVEMENTS." This ordinance was presented for passage and approval and after due discussion of same and deliberation thereof, Commissioner K. Hoskins, made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner C. F. Becker, that said ordinance be passed. The question was put by the mayor, asking all those Commissioners who favored the motion and the passage of said ordinance to vote "Aye" and those who opposed the same to vote "No". The following Commissioners voted "Aye"- Sam. H. Kerr, C. F. Becker, A. M. Walker, W. A. Behannon and Kenneth Hoskins. The following members voted "No"- None. The Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed. Said Ordinance is recorded elsewhere in these minutes.
