Minutes of former meetings read, and by move and second duly made and carried were approved as read.

Gity Manager C. N. Humason was instructed to collect rents due by W. L. Jones on the old Gity Lake, and from W. O. Seale, for foffice rent.

After discussing the matter it was moved by Joe C. Denman and seconded by E. W. Leach that the small Gould Pump at the Pumping Plant be taken up and set aside, leaving the base of same in place, and that the new pump be placed thereon. The Motion Carried unsnimously.

The matter of removing the extra boards on the spillway, which were placed there some time ago, was discussed after which it was moved by Joe C. Denman and seconded by A. M. Walker that said extra boards be removed and that Haloway White be notified that the fity will not need his land, on which the water could back, for water or reservoir purposes any longer. The motion carried unanimously.

The City manager was instructed to proceed with and complete the pavement on S. Raguet Street between Zeagler Avenue and Kerr Avenue, as soon asothe property owners on both sadds of said street have paid into the city treasury the amounts chargeable to each of them as part of the expense of said paving.
