MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING
OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD SEPT. 17th,
1925.

On this the 17th day of September, A. D. 1925, the City Commission met in called session, all members thereof being present. The Mayor stated that the purpose of the meeting was consider the offer of J. S. Moore and Sons to lay a six inch sewer line a distance of approximately 1750 feet from Chesnut Street to Everett Street in the Street running in front of the property of J.S. Moore, et als. at a price of 48 cents per foot complete, which includes the furnishing of all material, doing the necessary excavating, back filling and all labor necessary for the construction of said sewer line and putting in operation, to be paid for by the City of Lufkin in three annual payments beginning with the year 1926, without any interest.

Motion was made by Commissioner A. M. Walker and seconded by Commissioner E. W. Leach that the City accept the offer of J. S. Moore & Sons as aforesaid. All members voted "Aye" and none voted "No" and the Mayor declared the motion carried.
