

MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD OCT 15th,
1925.

On this the 15th day of October, A. D. 1925 a call meeting of the City Commission was held at the City Hall in said City, with all members thereof being present, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The Mayor stated that the purpose of the meeting was to consider the adoption of plans and specifications for the construction of an aerating plant at the city water works, and to transact such other business as may properly come before the meeting.

The Nepotism law as applying to W. L. Jones and Joe C. Denman was discussed and it was definitely decided that W. L. Jones and Joe C. Denman are related to each other within the second degree.

The matter of constructing a six inch sewer line on West Grove Avenue was discussed, and it appearing that E. J. Mantooth has made a proposition to lend the necessary money to the City for the construction of such sewer line, without interest, and as rentals are collected by the city from patrons of said sewer line, same are to be paid to E. J. Mantooth, quarterly and applied on his note held against the city. It is further agreed payments on said indebtedness shall be made as fully set out in the written instrument to be executed by the parties hereto, and which shall be in accordance with terms and conditions outlined in correspondence relative to such matter. On motion duly made and carried the proposition of E. J. Mantooth was accepted.

Plans and specifications for the construction of an aerating plant
