MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY  
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN,  
TEXAS, HELD February, 2nd, 1926.

Be it remembered that on this the 2nd day of February, A. D. 1926, there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said City; Present and presiding the Hon. J.W.Hawkins, Mayor, Joe C. Denman, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, A. M. Walker, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, W.A. Behannon, Commissioner of Ward No. 3 and E. W. Leach, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, C. N. Humason, City Manager, and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

Minutes of former meetings read, and on motion duly made and carried were approved as read.

City Manager Humason was instructed to proceed at once with the construction of two bridges at the following places, to-wit:- One on Denman Avenue at its crossing on Minley Avenue, and one on Denman Avenue at its crossing on Kerr Avenue.

A petition praying for the opening up of a street from the Huntington Highway to intersection of Lufkin Avenue and Chesnut Street, was read and after due consideration of same the City Manager was instructed to confer with the property owners along the proposed route, stating to them that if all property owners owning land over or through which said street would run, would dedicate, free of charge, to the city a right-of-way 50 feet wide (60 preferred), that the city would open same up.

Applications for service car license as follows, Alex Penson, (col) Lufkin, Texas, Tom McKinney, Lufkin, Texas, Hobby Galloway, Livingston, Texas, and J. W. Hamilton, Huntington, Texas, were presented, and after examination of same, it was unanimously carried that said applications be granted.

Bills and accounts due by the city to various parties, firms and corporations were presented for payment, and it appearing that such of said bills as had been audited and approved by the City Manager should be paid, on motion duly made and carried, same were allowed. See Minutes of accounts allowed.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion  
duly made and carried same adjourned.
