MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING
OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD
Sep. 23rd, 1927.

On this the 23rd day of September, A. D. 1927 there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said City: Present and presiding the following city Officers:- J. W. Hawkins, Mayor, Joe C. Denman, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, A. M. Walker, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, M. C. Spivey, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, E. W. Leach, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, V. R. Smitham, City Manager and W. O. Seale, City Attorney, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The Mayor announced that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss the question of and deciding on asking for bids for the construction and erection of an elevated water tower, and any other business that may properly come before the body.

After discussing the matter of asking for bids for elevated water tower, it was moved by M. C. Spivey and seconded by J. C. Denman that the City Manager be authorized to call for bids for elevated water tower. The motion carried unanimously and the City Manager is hereby authorized to call for bids for the erection of an elevated water tower.

The Commission went on record as favoring the putting of heavy fines on persons violating the ordinances of the city prohibiting the interference with the operation of the Fire Department equipment, and instructed the City Manager to instruct the CITY Judge to put heavy fines on people guilty of such violations.

It appearing that it would be beneficial to the City Officials in having knowledge relative to the different plans etc of Fire Stations and incinerator plants of some of the different cities round about, the City Manager was instructed to visit some other Cities in order to gather information to guide the Board in making decision as to the things best suited for the needs of the City in the construction of a new Fire Station and a Garbage Incinerator.

There being no further business to come before the meeting on motion duly made and carried same adjourned.
