Smitham, City Manager, F. 0 . Seale, City Attorney, and T. L. Drann, Gity, when the following proceed-



The purpose of the meeting, as announced by the kayor, was to declare the result of the recent city election held for the purpose of electing a Mayor and a Commissioner from Ward No. 3, and to transact any other business as may properly come before the meeting.

An ordinance having been prepared, and which is of record in these minutes, teelanage the result of the election held on the 5th day of April, 1927 for the purpose of electing a Mayor and a comaissioner from Ward No. 3 of the lity of Iufkin, was presented for passage and approval, and on motion made by $L$. W. Walker and seconded by E. W. Leach, saia ordinance.was duly passed and approved by a unanimous vote of the City Commission.

The Mayor recommended the payment to $\nabla$. R. Smitham, City iranager, the sum of $\$ 200.00$ as services for engineering duties performed in connection with the improvements around the court house. On Motion duly made by Joe C. Denman and seconded by E. W. Leach, it was unanimously carried that the said sum of - 200.00 be paid to hr. Smitham as aforesaid.

Discussion was had relative to settlement with perties for paving suits, against whom judgment had been obtained before the settlement or agreement was had in court with those parties who were contesting such suits. After considerable discussion of the question, it was moved by Joe $G$. Demman and seconded by E. W. Jeach that the city do not remit or refund any part of judgents obtained on paving contracts
or assessments, in the April term 1927 of the District ${ }^{C}$ court of Angelina County, Texas. The Mayor having put the question, all members of the commission voted in favor of said motion, and the Mayor declared same cartied.

The City Manager reported that the City had collected the sum of $\$ 50.00$ as rental from a show for the use of the property known as Jones Lake, and recommended that said amount be paid the Volunteer $P_{\text {ire }}$ epartment for use in defraying the expense of the District Firemen's convention recently held in the City. After considering such recommendation it was moved by A. M. Walker and seconded by R.W. Leach that said amount of $\$ 50.00$ paid to the Volunterr Fire Department as recommended by the $C_{i t y}$ Manager. The motion carried unanimously.

The City Manager stated that he was very much in need of a caterpillar tractor ( 5 ton) for use in the building and maintaing of the dir pt streets of the city, and asked the City Commission to give him authority to make such purchase. The matter having been duly considered it was moved by Joe C. Denman and seconded by M. C. Spivey that the City Manager by given authority to buy a tractor as aforesaid. The motion carried unanimously.

It appearing that the instalation of the "White Nay" or lights around the Court House had been completed, and that a bill for the Cityrs part of the cost of same had been presented, and it further aryearine that said bill had been approved by the City Manager, on motion made by .... Leach and seconded by in. C. Spivey, same was allowed.


There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried, same adjourned.
