MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE  
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS,  
HELD MARCH 6th, A. D. 1928.

Be it remembered that on this the 6th day of March, A.D. 1928, there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said City: Present and presiding the following officers of the City, to-wit: J. W. Hawkins, Mayor, Joe C. Denman, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, A.M. Walker, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, M. C. Spivey, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, E. W. Leach, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, V. R. Smitham, City Manager, W. O. Seale, City Attorney and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, When the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

Minutes of former meetings read and on motion duly made and carried were approved as read.

-----oOo-----

A petition of Coke Murphey, et al for extension of white way system from Cotton square to Raguet street, and a petition of W.D. Newsom et als for extension of white way from <sup>on Raguet Ave</sup> Southern Pacific Ry. to second street was presented for consideration of the City Commission. After much discussion of the matter it was moved by E. W. Leach and seconded by Joe C. Denman that if the citizens would provide and install white way standards on said streets that the city would pay the power bill for operation of same. The motion having been put by the mayor, said motion carried unanimously.

In connection with the installation of white way on Ellise Ave. from Cotton square to Raguet Street, it was moved by Joe C. Denman, and seconded by M. C. Spivey that if such white way is installed that the city purchase and install two light standards, one to be for the benefit of the Presbyterian Church and one to be for the benefit of the Catholic Church. The motion carried unanimously.

Walker, M. C. Spivey and E. W. Leach. "No"- None.


Accounts and bills due by the city to various parties, firms and
