The Mayor announced that the purpose of the meeting was to consider the question of passing a resolution concelling gas franchise heretofore granted to L.F.Troxel for reason of his, the said Troxel's not complying with thatain terms of said franchise, also for purpose of passing an ordinance approving contract with Scott Shambaugh for additional street paving, and authorizing the Mayor to execute in the name of the City such contract, and to do and perform such other business as may properly come before the meeting.
